2. We agree to come to group prepared.

4. We agree to encourage and pray for each other.

- We agree to provide encouragement for every member of our group.
- We agree to support one another and lift each other up in prayer.

5. We agree to be accountable to one another.

- We agree to let the members of our group hold us accountable to the commitments we make in whatever loving ways we decide upon. As a group, we choose to commit together to the accountability necessary to stay the course and answer the call to become men who are faithful to what we have resolved.
