

Below is a list of Graduate Qualifications. In order to be eligible for participation in a Men of Resolution Signing Ceremony, each MOR Graduate must have demonstrated the following.

1. **Commitment to Attendance**

Participant has attended meetings schedules meetings and group events, missing no more than three (special exceptions can be made on an individual basis, but this should be rare).

2. **Commitment to Participation**

Participant has actively participated and contributed to the success of the group, modeled cooperation individually and with the group.

3. **Put Forth His Best Effort**

Participant has made a consistent effort to complete all reading assignments, answer all discussion questions, weekly “Courageous Challenges” and other “action” items designated by group leader (with the emphasis on quality).

4. **Demonstrated Commitment to the Group**

In general, the participant has maintained the Group Agreement, came to group on time and took the group seriously.

5. **Demonstrates a Desire to Follow Jesus**

Participant has demonstrated a true desire to follow Christ’s commandment given to each of us in Matthew 28:19-20.

*“Go, then, to all peoples everywhere and make them my disciples: baptize them in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, and teach them to obey everything I have commanded you. And I will be with you always, to the end of the age.”*

Our call as follower’s of Christ, and Men of Resolution, is to “Go and make disciples”. Each Graduate must demonstrate a desire to disciple others as Christ has commanded.

Men of Resolution group study participants who do not meet these qualifications should be offered appropriate assistance to succeed (possibly including the option of retaking the MOR group - MOR Leadership decision).
